

The Texas Association of Journalism Educators announces it annual contest for high school and junior high newspapers and broadcasts. Categories include concept, writing, design and photography/artwork.

The entries must be received on or before Jan. 31, 2019.

Awards will be posted at taje.org by March 31, 2019.

CONTEST INFORMATION

The contest entry fees will be \$3 per entry. Advisers **MUST** be TAJE members to enter. Profits from the contest benefit TAJE projects, including scholarship programs.

The contest will focus on the quality of concept, writing and design to give newspaper, online newspaper and broadcast staff members an opportunity to gain recognition for their individual journalistic accomplishments.

The deadline for receiving entries is Jan. 31, 2019.

Winning entries will be awarded certificates of superior, excellent or honorable mention as judged by qualified scholastic journalism persons. **New for 2018-2019:** Entries receiving a superior rating will be eligible for the Best of the Best award. One overall winner will be selected from each contest group (print and online newspaper: concept, objective writing, opinion writing, design, photography/artwork; broadcast: coverage and talent).

Entries must have been published between Feb. 1, 2018, and this year's deadline. Do not enter pieces in both print newspaper and online newspaper.

Entries should be submitted through the TAJE web site.

Print newspaper: Upload appropriately named PDFs (for categories N1-N18 and N27-N35)) or JPGs (for categories N19-26). **The naming scheme is Categorynumber school studentname.**

Online newspaper: Submit a URL. Please make sure links will remain active.

Broadcast: Upload videos to YouTube or Vimeo. Submit a URL.

B5. Anchor: Two minutes of your anchor talent.

B6. On-Air: Two minutes of field talent.

N17. Personal Opinion Column: Opinion piece reflecting the writer's opinion on a local, state or national topic

N18. Entertainment Review: Review of movie, book, play, restaurant, concert, CD, etc.

Photography/Artwork

(Include related captions with photos) N19. News Photo: Emphasis on action; focused on event.

N20. Feature Photo: Strong emphasis on human interest.

N21. Sports Action Photo: Action-

centered. Should be carefully cropped.

N22. Sports Feature Photo: Humaninterest centered; what happens behind the scenes or between plays. N23. Portrait: Informal/environmental or studio portrait.

N24. Photo Portfolio: Five photos with captions

N25. Editorial Cartoon: Include page with cartoon

N26. Original Artwork: Include page with art (can include art accompanying content or comic strips)
