# SUMMER VIRTUAL WORKSHOP

(You can always register your students as individuals if it's cheaper - for example if you have six students.)

## ILPC/TAJE Virtual Summer Workshop Classes

**THEME CONCEPT AND DEVELOPMENT** – There's a difference between "expected" and "snappy" themes. This class can make a huge difference in the impact you make on your readers. You will be inspired to take a deeper and more creative look at your cover, endsheets, openings and closings. Instructors Becky Tate, Bruce Watterson

**UIL PREP CLASS** – If it's your dream to compete at the UIL State Academic Contest, this is the class for you. Students will learn strategies to be successful in the UIL Journalism Contests. All five contests will be covered. This class will be writing intensive. Instructor Mikyela Tedder

**PHOTOJOURNALISM FOR PUBLICATIONS** – The workshop is designed for photographers looking to learn composition techniques and improve the overall impact of their photography. Students must have their own digital cameras and other equipment. Depending on the number of student enrolled, the class may split into a beginniner class and an intermediate/advanced class. Instructors Mark Murray, Mitchell Franz and Deanne Brown.

**ADVISERS' CLASS** – This sequence is designed to help and to motivate advisers. It will focus on learning the fundamentals of staff management, team building, law and ethics, coverage, reporting and writing, editing, design and graphics. Instructor Charla Harris

**DIGITAL REPORTING** - This sequence will focus on creating multimedia packages for online newspapers and broadcasts using your phone (or other equipment). Instructor Margie Raper

**ADVANCED WRITING** - This intensive writing sequence will focus on advanced techniques. This class is restricted to students who have at least one year experience. Instructor Bobby Hawthorne

**YEARBOOK ESSENTIALS** - Designed for first-year staffers and section editors, this session will cover writing, management and design concept of individual sections. This sequence also includes some discussion of trends and innovations. Instructor Alyssa Boehringer

**NEWSPAPER ESSENTIALS** – Designed for first-year staffers and section editors, this session will cover editorial content, news and feature writing styles, ethics, student press rights and social media. Instructor Leland Mallett
